



Charter of commitment to the REACH Regulation

January 1st 2023 Version 7

Since the entry into force of REACH Regulation (EC) No 1907/2006 on 1 June 2007 and the various obligations linked to this regulation, we have carried out an inventory of our products and the origin of each one in order to define our status with regard to REACH.

Under REACH, VYNEX are considered as importers/suppliers of articles.

In this context, we are required to :

- Inform the recipients of our articles if they contain a substance on the candidate list (SVHC list) at a concentration of more than 0.1% weight by weight (art.33 of REACH).
- Inform the ECHA (European Chemicals Agency) if one of the SVHC substances is imported in quantities of more than one tonne per year and 0.1% mass/mass.

To this end, we work closely with our suppliers to find out whether the products we distribute contain SVHC, and we carry out laboratory tests throughout the year to confirm these declarations. These tests are repeated annually.

If we are concerned by the obligation mentioned above, we transmit the necessary information as soon as possible to the recipients of the articles. As we market a large number of items, we use a probabilistic approach to access information. We also monitor this list, which is updated every six months.

Since 5 January 2021, we have also been declaring to ECHA, the European Chemicals Agency, all our articles containing at least one SVHC at more than 0.1% m/m using their SCIP portal.

We will continue to monitor any changes in our REACH status, as our aim is to maintain customer satisfaction and deliver products that comply with current requirements.
